- Library book fines/process update (6:50-6:55)
 - Stewart-students who don't return books can't check out a new book from the library. There will be grade level libraries from community donations for students to take home whenever they want them.
 - Lincoln-make sure students leave their building with no debt -using fundraisers to cover the fines. Payment plan for parents to pay-off fines and notes home to remind them to pay. Book drive to get books for check-out from grade level libraries
 - Middle School - Lost book if not returned at the end of the year-get free return of books and charges won't follow students. Students can check out books from MS if they have not returned book from other buildings, if they don't return books from MS can't check out new books
 - High School - Send out reminders overdue books, pay a friend's fine, students can't walk across the stage at graduation if all fees are not paid-including library book fines.
